



CODE OF CONDUCT CONTRACT

The undersigned parent(s), guardian(s), and camper/CIT acknowledge that the implementation of rules at the Middlesex County Camp are created to foster a safe and wholesome environment with an underlying goal to provide a rewarding and enriching summer camp experience for the camper.

Accordingly, we do hereby agree to the following rules:

1. Campers/CITs are not permitted to bring any of the following items to camp and those found with the following items will be sent home immediately without a refund or ability to return to camp during the current season.

Cell Phones / Smart Phones / iPods / Internet Tablets such as iPads and e-readers.

Drugs (except Rx Meds)

Explosive materials such as fireworks

Alcoholic Beverages

Knives or guns

Tobacco Products / Electronic Cigarettes

Matches or lighters

Computers

Electronic Games

If a camper brings any of these items to camp or is found with any of these items during camp, they will be dismissed from camp; the parent/guardian will be called immediately to pick up the child; and the child will not be allowed back at the camp during current year. The Camp will not provide a refund for the week's fees paid when a child is sent home for violating these provisions. A vote by the Camp's Board of Director will determine if the child may return in a future year.

Depending on the severity of the offence committed by the child, the camp reserves the right and maybe required to notify applicable authorities.

2. The following items are also prohibited at camp:

Radios / Boom boxes

Fans

Food items

Pressurized Spray Cans

Cash / Valuables

Pets

Items running on lithium-ion batteries

Hoverboards

If a camper brings any of these items to camp, the items will be confiscated and held in the office until the end of the week, at which time the parent/guardian will need to sign for their return. The camp will not be responsible for any of the foregoing items whether confiscated or not.

3. In Addition, campers are expected to follow the instructions of camp staff and adjust their behavior accordingly during their camp experience. In the event that they do not do so, at the sole discretion of the camp, the camp reserves the right to dismiss campers from the camp and call their parents to be picked up. In such event, there will not be a refund.

The undersigned parent(s)/guardian(s) and camper acknowledge that they are voluntary agreeing to these camp rules and regulations, and understand the implications when they are not followed.
